1. What parts of the weekend's message most spoke to you?
2. Was there something about this message that surprised you? What and why?
3. What questions did these verses and the message raise for you?
4. Where do we see Jesus Christ in these verses? OR What in this passage helped you see more of Jesus, or what moved you to love him more?
5. Why are these verses in the Bible? What might the Bible lose if this passage was left out? What's the author's main point?
6. How will your belief and behaviour change as a result of the message/reading? (You might want to encourage the group members to take action). What is the Spirit leading you to do in obedience to this message/reading this week?
7. What can the group pray for you from the message?
8. How can you share the joy, peace, and conviction you've been given by God with others?
