COSTING

Interns will receive regular mentoring and also become mentors over the course of the year.

TEAM SEEDS SERVING

Interns will serve as part of Team Seeds. The internship is to serve the mission of Seeds, rather than a specific ministry area. This means you won't necessarily be placed in one specific role for the year, but will be involved more broadly in church events such as Sunday services, Kidventure and Road to Christmas.
